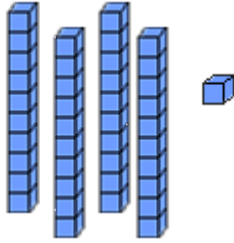
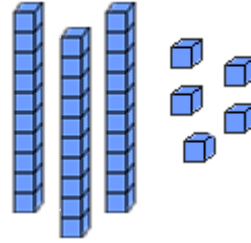


Possible Solutions

- a) Compare the base ten blocks and use $>$, $<$, or $=$ to complete the number sentence. Explain your thinking.



4 tens and 1 one makes 41.



3 tens and 5 ones makes 35.

35 has fewer tens than 41 so, 35 is less than 41.

$$35 < 41$$

- b) Terry has 25 marbles. Will has 16 marbles. Who has more marbles? Use $<$, $>$, or $=$ to complete the number sentence and explain your thinking.

25 is more than 16 because when I count up I say 25 after I say 16. 25 is to the right of 16 on the number line.

$$25 > 16$$
